Construction Updates

- The podium is currently under construction, with concrete placement scheduled for the third week of April for the thirdfloor steel area. The post-tensioned (PT) slab is already complete. This is the structure on which the modular boxes will sit.
- The site is preparing to receive modular boxes in early May; a crane will need to be used to stack these boxes.
- Crane assembly is planned on-site. Initially, the upper lot at 24
 North Street won't be required for the first, smaller crane
 setup. Later in May, a larger crane will be brought in for
 module stacking, requiring use of the parking lot at 24 North
 Street for two days. We will need to close the parking lot
 during that time.



Construction Timeline

- Demolition: 6 weeks (mid-May 23) complete.
- Site & Foundations: 6 months (May-Nov 23) complete.
- Concrete and Steel Podium: 5 months (Nov 23-April 24)
- Stacking of modular boxes: 3 months (May 24 July 24)
- Vertical construction: 10 months (Jan-Nov 24)
- Finish site work & landscaping: 2 months (July-Sept 24)
- Expected Completion: November 2024

Phase 2a and Relocation Updates

- As we near construction completion and prepare for Phase 2a, families will either move into the new building or move off site
- HOU has started working with residents eligible for 3BR units to plan for upcoming moves and issue Notice of Eligibility (NOE) for relocation assistance
- HOU is on site Mondays and Wednesdays to answer any relocation questions

Re-Occupancy Overview

- 1. Any household relocated off-site who received a notice to quit in a no-fault eviction
- 2. Priority households who are currently living in Phase II and had already moved once (Phase I relocatees)
- 3. Priority households who moved off site
- 4. Priority households who remained in place in Phase II buildings (Phase II priority households)
- 5. Non-priority households living in Phase II
- 6. Non-priority households relocated off-site
