Construction Updates

- Foundation work completed December 2023
- Concrete pouring completed early March 2024
- Podium under construction. Anticipated mid-April completion
- Site is preparing to receive modular boxes by May
- Crane assembly anticipated mid to late April
 - Intention is to assemble the crane from within the site



Construction Timeline

- Demolition: 6 weeks (mid-May 23)
- Site & Foundations: 6 months (May-Nov 23)
- Concrete and Steel Podium: 5 months (Nov 23-April 24)
- Vertical construction: 10 months (Jan-Nov 24)
- Finish site work & landscaping: 2 months (July-Sept 24)
- Expected Completion November 2024

- Security cameras are live. Notices go to the construction team and police if someone trespasses
